# **New Business**

#### Al LB:

**1.** Last year we formed a committee to finalize a Medical Director for our squad. Al spoke to Dr G from Princeton who agreed to be our Medical Director provided all his insurance related questions are cleared.

Having a Medical Director helps us participate in all the new Protocols that State has come up with.

Motion forwarded by Al, Seconded by Prem G and passed unanimously.

State changed 4 protocols that we can carry baby Aspirins, CPAP, Narcan.

It is agreed that Al LB will work with line once the Medical Director is on board.

Equipment and any money on training to be spent will be voted by the members.

2. Our CPR Manikins has taken a beating and it is time to replace them. The ones we have are not robust and we need to buy a set of 4 CPR babies (around 500 dollars) and 4 adult manikins (\$900).

We have people using our manikins and we should get some donation from them. Bill K suggested Al LB to come up with a suggestions and Line will decide on buying the same. A committee will be formed. The motion is tabled till next meeting.

3. Uniforms: Al LB got a quote for the 511 Polo shirts that costs around \$50 a piece. We have budget for buying Polo shirts.

As members are coming on calls in different Polos and T-Shirts. We need to have a uniform. Motion is on table and seconded by Prem.

Brenda suggested that instead of one person deciding on the uniform, a committee be formed. 7500 is our current uniform budget.

Al recommended a Polo shirt with Squad Logo on the chest, and EMS on the back.

Line tried to get a quote from vendor who didn't show up. The problem we had was male Polo shirt and Female shirts were different. That is the reason we started looking for other vendors.

Line is responsible for the uniforms and recommended Polo shirt and Tactical Pant. Motion amended by Brian and seconded by Brian.

#### Frank LB:

Frank suggested replace all the normal regulators on portable oxygen cylinders to have the high pressure add on piece.

Brian LB confirmed that in all our trucks there is at least one portable O2 tank with this add-on piece. As it cost around 150 bucks for each regulator to replace it has to be voted by all the members.

Brian LB will check and get back to us in the September meeting.

Frank suggested we get some Kendall Park First Aid Squad plates, so that the new members can have them on their cars.

# Ray W

Presented a motion to get members trained on using Narcan and carry them on our rigs.

Motion was tabled till we get Dr G as our medical director.

# **Brian LB**

Brian presented a motion to spend \$600 to have all the portable O2 tanks to have add-on for high pressure O2 flow so that ALS can use it for CPAP.

Motion seconded by Prem. Brian LB withdrew the motion after Nicole and Kara convinced that it is not needed as ALS carries them on their Portable O2 tanks and if needed we can use main O2 for high flow O2. As we have at least one regulator with add-on piece, we can always shift it to another tank if needed.

Motion to spend up to \$2000 to install a drive cam on A-64 as a trial. Seconded by Liz.

SB3 voted this down as non KPFARS members voted against it.

Motion voted down
