EMT Course Overview

Thank you for registering for a New Jersey EMT program with Community Safety Consultants. CSC uses a multimedia approach for educating our students. Aside from classroom activities, e-learning, and DVD's, our students will be given the opportunity to use field equipment for various interactive scenarios. These scenarios are based on real life situations which will help individuals recognize the different types of life threatening emergencies. Our goal and mission is to train individuals for any medical emergency, and we have a talented team of educators with extensive backgrounds in Emergency Medical Services. At Community Safety Consultants we challenge our students to be the best providers to support their communities.

About the hybrid program:

This class is recommended for students who are at a college level of learning. You are expected to have good study habits, and the ability to independently study before class. There is a **GREAT** amount of reading for this class - please plan for 10-15 hours/week. Lectures are provided online. Our in-class time is dedicated to skills only. Completion of all lectures and online quizzes is required for completion of the class. You must have reliable internet access in order to complete this class.

Class Attendance:

Due to the nature of a hybrid program <u>ALL in-class sessions are mandatory</u>. Skill sessions are integral to becoming an EMT. We have invested much time and effort into your EMT program, please do the same for us. CSC has submitted class hours, including online time, to the State of New Jersey. In order to complete the class, we must prove to the state you were present during all sessions - or have made arrangements to make up the time with a CSC NJ EMT Instructor. We cannot accept make ups from other training agencies, other healthcare providers, etc. These additional class sessions are with a CSC staff, and cost \$25 per hour, as we have already scheduled the necessary time for your education.

Dress Code:

A collared white shirt (polo or button down), blue or black pants (no jeans or stretchy pants), dark shoes covering your entire foot (work boots preferred), a watch (showing seconds), stethoscope and nametag are required for the EMT program. You are expected to dress in the student uniform during all sessions. A nametag will be provided for you. Stethoscopes are available for purchase at our office, or available at retail/online stores.

Books:

A **Premier Package EMT textbook** is **required for class** - books can be purchased and picked up at our office. Please begin reading the textbook. For the online component, a course ID will be assigned to you on the first day of class. Feel free to redeem your access code through www.jblearning.com, but note that required lectures/quizzes/etc. will NOT record a grade until after your course ID is assigned. A student handbook will be provided - that may also be picked up at our office. The handbook will outline our policies, procedures, guidelines, and expectations for the program. It will serve as a valuable resource during your education, and practice, as an EMT.

NJ Registration:

Registration with the NJ DOH is required for class. Please visit www.njems.us and create an account. SAVE YOUR ID NUMBER AND PASSWORD. After your account is created, please log-in, and from the home tab (at top) click the "Apply for EMT Initial Standard Certification" link. The system will then verify your personal information, and ask two questions about criminal background. Please answer accordingly. We must register you on the first day of class with the State of New Jersey.
