<u>Navigation:</u> While there are Garmin GPS units in both A62 & A63, there are magnetic phone mounts placed in both the rigs for your convenience.

Rig Checks: All members are required to understand each equipment and supplies in the rig. Please talk to your Crew Chief for more help.
