Stretchers

Each stretcher costs over \$15,000 and must be maintained and eventually replaced.



Essential Supplies

Trauma materials, oxygen tanks, EpiPens, and critical supplies cost up to \$15,000 yearly



Ambulance Replacement

With a \$300,000 price tag per vehicle, maintaining our fleet requires significant investment.



Disposable Medical Supplies

Single-use equipment, due to infection control policies, can total up to \$15,000 annually



Defibrillators

Each ambulance requires a \$5,000 defibrillator to restart hearts during cardiac emergencies.



Equipment Maintenance

Ongoing upkeep of defibrillators and other life-saving devices can total up to \$10,000.
